

The Women's Information Service provides a culturally respectful and safe place for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander women. You don't have to have an issue to come in, you can just drop by to have a yarn and a cup of tea or coffee.

The Women's Information Service (WIS) is a free and confidential service for all women in South Australia. We are committed to providing accurate information and aim to empower women to make informed decisions.

You can talk to us about:

- family life and relationships
- domestic / family violence, sexual assault and safety
- health and wellbeing
- housing options
- financial matters
- women's groups and events
- education, training and career paths
- anything at all.

If you're not sure what services can assist you we can help you find the right one without going around in circles. WIS is not a counselling service but provides a safe and respectful place for women to come in and have a yarn about anything. We will do what we can to provide you with the support that you need.

Our services for women include:

- information and referral
- computer/internet access
- Family Court Support
- SMS call back
- rural phone link up
- tax help
- volunteering opportunities
- financial councelling (first and third Wedneday of each month)
- Ombudsman outreach.

WIS also provides support to staff in organisations that are providing services to women.

For service providers we offer:

- Information and referral options, for when your staff need more choices for their clients.
- WIS Talks group of up to 20 can visit WIS or we can arrange to visit your service to inform your staff or appropriate client groups about WIS (metro Adelaide only).
- WIS interview room, which service providers can book for female clients.

The WIS interview room has a cordless phone and wifi connection. It is suitable for services to speak to women who would prefer a city central location or need additional discretion when meeting with a service. Services can book a one-off appointment or a regular time to be available as an outreach.
